Many fond memories were had boating, 4-wheeling in dad's International Scout with friends, snowmobiling, and campfires with family and lifelong friends. The Levi family has a long history in Lake George, as dad's great grandparents Vincent Levi and Dina Levi built the first Levi cabin back in 1924. Dad's passion was classic cars, he would spend many a Sunday, rising early to be the first at a car show to get the best spot in the shade and where he could watch all his favorite classic cars come by and listen to the 50's music from his generation.
