Laurence O. "Bud" Huntley, age 86, of Farwell, passed away on Thursday, August 6, at Isabella County Medical Care Facility. He was born the son of Orison H and Hazel (Bell) Huntley on Feb. 16, 1929, in Portland, Michigan. Bud served with the US Army during the Korean War.
