Lena Elizabeth Moore, at age 92 years young was welcomed home by her loving Lord and reunited with her late husband, Charles "Charlie" Moore, daughter Linda Dianne Moore and daughter-in-law Jo Ellen Moore on November 13, 2012. She was surrounded by her loving family as she peacefully passed in her home in Coleman. Lena was born on December 10, 1919 to parents Harry Myers and Olive Wilhelm in Waterloo, IN, the second child and eldest girl out of six, her siblings including Hugh, Ruth, Ralph, Marion and Beulah. Lena came to Michigan with her family at age 18 after her mother had passed. She met her husband and love of her life, Charles Austin Moore in 1938. They were married on May 31, 1940 and truly enjoyed their life together for 54 years until Charles passed away in 1995 due to cancer. Together, they raised 2 girls and 2 boys (Shirley, Linda, David and William), bred and raised farm animals, grew many, many crops and thoroughly enjoyed the company of family and friends. Lena was a graduate of Ashley High School in Indiana, class of 1937. She was an active member of Faith United Methodist Church in Coleman, enjoyed reading, cooking, baking, gardening, hard work and being an active volunteer and leader in 4-H programs in Isabella County.
