Lina Ruth Teeter, age 89 of Clare, passed away peacefully with family present on Monday, February 20, 2017 at the Woodland Hospice House in Mt. Pleasant. Lina was born the youngest of 8 children to the late Edward and Agnes (Gleason) Ball on May 24, 1927 in Mt. Pleasant. She was united in marriage to Harley L. Teeter on September 17, 1955 at the Sacred Heart Parish in Mt. Pleasant; with Harley predeceasing her on March 4, 1975. Lina was a lifelong resident of the Mt. Pleasant and Clare area; she was a faithful member of Our Lady of Hope Parish – St. Cecilia Site, helping with Funeral Dinners for over 40 years. She had worked in the kitchen at the Clare Public Schools for 9 years before working in food service at CMU where she retired after 7 years.
