Lyle R. Gallagher, age 86 of Clare, passed away Saturday, May 30, 2015 at the MidMichigan Medical Center in Clare. Lyle was born the son of the late Carl A. and Lula (Gantz) Gallagher on September 16, 1928 in Maple Rapids. He was united in marriage to Geraldine "Gerry" Baker on September 10, 1949. Lyle had served his Country proudly in the U.S. Marines during WWII. Following his service he worked as a Bulk Milk Hauler in both Shiawassee and Clare Counties. Following his retirement he and Gerry enjoyed spending time with both family and friends at their winter home in Florida and summer getaway at Higgins Lake.

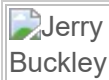
