Lynette K. Hutchinson, 70, of Clare, passed away peacefully on Thursday, April 9, 2020 at MidMichigan Medical Center in Midland.

Lynette was born March 26, 1950, the daughter of Marion and Laural (Allen) Hildebrandt in Gladwin. She graduated from Beaverton High School in 1968. She was united in marriage to Frank Hutchinson on June 15, 1968, at the Eagle Church of God in Clare, and they enjoyed almost fifty-two years together.

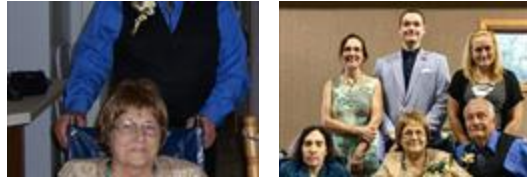
