



## Maredda Magnus

June 5, 1957 - December 28, 2021

Maredda L. Magnus, age 64, of Clare, passed away on Tuesday, December 28, 2021 at her home. She was born the daughter of Edward and Marion (Rutter) Magnus on June 5, 1957 in Mt. Pleasant, Michigan. After graduation from Clare High School class of 1975, Maredda studied P.E., Health and Psychology at Huntington University where she received her BA in Education. She had volunteered at "I work for Jesus and at Kenosha First Assembly of God, and taught and coached at Kenosha Unified School District in Kenosha, Wisconsin. Maredda had also served in the Mission Field at several locations around the World.
