Marian Pearl (Cuddie) House, age 93 of Clare, met her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ face to face on February 25, 2018. Marian was born the daughter of the late Warren and Mary J. (Gray) Cuddie on December 11, 1924 in Gladwin near Skeels. She was united in marriage to Arnold L. House on Easter Sunday, April 1, 1945 with Arnold predeceasing her on May 23, 2011. She and Arnold met at the Apple Blossom Camp (Good News) north of Gladwin; they had a dairy farm south of Clare. Marian was an active and faithful member of the First Baptist Church of Clare.

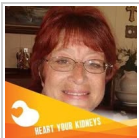
