Marian Zeleznik, age 92 was born to August Hofweber and Amy Hofweber (Campbell) in Detroit on December 2, 1928 and passed away on June 26, 2021 in Mt. Pleasant. She earned her pilots license at 16 years of age and enjoyed flying in her younger years.
