Marilyn Jean Cassidy, age 79 of Clare, passed away Wednesday, January 23, 2019 at the Horizon Senior Living in Clare. Marilyn was born on May 9, 1939, in Cleveland, Ohio; the daughter of the late Kermit and Bernice (Beutel) Carlisle. She was united in marriage to Harry Mailley in January of 1958 until he passed away in July of 1995. Marilyn then married Duane “Bob” Cassidy in 2000 with him predeceasing her in 2012. She achieved her dream of owning horses when she moved to a farm in Gladwin in 1974. Mahogany and Penny (horses) joined the family in 1974. When she married Bob she sold the farm and moved to Grayling; following Bob’s death she moved to Clare in 2012. She had been a member of St. Anne’s Catholic Church in Edenville enjoying the time spent in the Choir and then once moving to Clare belonging to the Our Lady of Hope Parish – St. Cecilia Site.
