August 13, 2020, Marion Aileen (Crapo) Miller, age 83, went to live with The Lord she loved and served after a long struggle with dementia. She lived in Loomis, MI, for the last 60 years, and passed away surrounded by family. She is survived by her loving husband, Ezra E Miller, who cared for her during her last years; children Scott and Brenda (Miller) Rieger, Steve and Diane (Miller) Whitteberry, Marvin and Susan (Miller) Spears, Darrel and Lara Miller, and Mark and Sharon (Miller) Johnson; 19 grandchildren and 15 great-grandchildren. Ten months later, on October 27, 1956 they married. Marion was a devoted wife and mother. She worked alongside Ezra in

establishing Miller Poultry & Feed, doing all the bookkeeping as well, while bearing and raising 5 children. She and Ezra taught their children the truths of the Bible and the value of hard work, honesty and respect.

Marion loved and followed the Lord Jesus Christ, serving many years on the board of First Church of the Nazarene in Mt. Pleasant, MI. She taught the college age Sunday School class as well often bringing those students to her home on Sundays for fellowship and a home cooked meal.
