December 30, 1943 - June 12, 2017

Marshall L. Dodge, age 73, of Lake, passed away on Monday, June 12, at McLaren Central Michigan hospital in Mt. Pleasant. He was born Dec. 30, 1943 in Flint, after high school he served in the US armed Forces from 1963 to 1966. He married the former Gwen Beeler on March 30, 1994. Marshall had retired as a splicer with Michigan Bell telephone and later Ameritech/AT&T in the Pontiac area. He moved to his home in Lake from Orion, Michigan in 2000. Unable to sit still in his retirement, he went to work as a Plumbing Department sales associate at Home Depot in Mt. Pleasant.

Marshall is survived by his wife, Gwen, his children, Trevor Dodge, Debra Geldhof, and Crystal Bettingham, his step-children, Kim Calvert and Brad McConnell, Several grandchildren, three great-grandchildren and his brother, Ron Dodge. He was preceded in death by a brother, William Dodge.

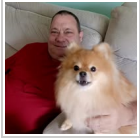
