Meta "Mae" W. Baumgarth, age 100 of Clare, passed away on Saturday, September 19, 2015 at Green Acres Assisted Living in Mt. Pleasant where she was a resident. Mae was born the daughter of the late Julius and Ernestine (Bittner) Hohnke on February 12, 1915 in Sebewaing.
