Our princess, Miranda Maria Huntoon, age 19 years old, went to heaven on October 13th 2024, at 10:59pm with her family by her side.

Miranda was born on May 28th, 2005. to Brad and Erika Huntoon and resided in Maple Rapids MI for a majority of her life. Miranda attended school through the GIRESD at Hillcrest SXI. Although Miranda endured an extensive medical journey, her smile would light up the darkest days. She loved watching movies on her iPad, playing games with her big brothers on the iPad, attending all her brothers' sporting events, having books read to her, traveling, Huntoon family camping trips, and listening to Justin Bieber (Thanks Aunt Manna) and TuPac (Thanks Grandma Melva) Miranda wasn't just a survivor, she was a warrior. She spent a large portion of her life in and out of the hospital and showed us just how much fight and determination she had with each medical bump in the road she endured. She was diagnosed at 4 months old with Lissencephaly originating from birth and later diagnosed with Lennox Gastaut Syndrome as her disease progressed.

We would like to extend our deepest gratitude to Sparrow PICU and 5 Foster for all their exceptional care from early on in her life and to Mott Children's Hospital in Ann Arbor MI for the countless hours they spent trying to figure out what illness or illnesses she was experiencing. 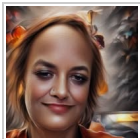
