Neil Joseph Thelen, 92 years old, of Lake Station, MI, died Monday, May 4, 2026 at his home.

He was born in Lansing on November 19, 1933 to Roman and Helen Thelen. Neil attended Saint Mary's Catholic School before joining the United States Air Force. After serving his country, Neil returned home to work for AT&T and married the love of his life, Frances (Miles), in 1957. After 30 years of employment with AT&T, Neil and Frances retired and moved to their house on Crooked Lake at Lake Station, MI.

Neil served his community in several ways. He was active in the Knights of Columbus, serving as a Grand Knight for a period of time.
