Patsy Ann Myers, age 72 of Clare passed away Tuesday, October 7, 2014 following a courageous battle with Cancer. Patsy was born the daughter of the late Charles and Elizabeth (Dumitru) Newman on August 16, 1942 in Gladwin. She was united in marriage to Frank M. Myers on December 22, 1962 at the Assembly of God Church in Gladwin. Patsy had lived her entire life in the Clare and Gladwin area. She had began her working career as an Registered Nurse before returning to school to get her teaching degree; she had taught kindergarten in Gladwin for 33 years. Patsy was a loving wife and mother but her pride and joy were her three grandchildren. She was a member and attended the Arthur Center Church of God.

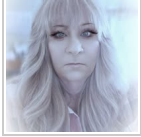
