



## Raymond Francis Brusseau

January 10, 1940 - June 18, 2018

Raymond Francis Brusseau, age 78, of Five Lakes, passed away peacefully with his wife by his side, on Monday, June 18, 2018 at the Aleda E. Lutz VA Medical Center of Saginaw. On January 10, 1940, Ray was born the son of Leon and Marian (Schmidt) Brusseau in Detroit, MI. Ray was a graduate of Wayne State University and a member of the U.S. Air Force. During his working years, Ray had served as a computer programmer for General Motors for over twenty years before taking a job with the Electronic Data Systems of Detroit.
