Richard was born the son of the late Donald and Gladys (Proctor) Arrington on April 8, 1933 in Wapakoneta, Ohio. Richard served his Country in the Army during the Korean War.

Richard was united in marriage to Marian A. Richmond on August 1, 1959. Richard worked at CATA (Capital Area Transportation Authority) in Lansing as their First Class Diesel Mechanic, retiring after 34 years; prior to working at CATA, he worked for 11 years at Motor Wheel Corporation also located in Lansing, he and Marian moved from East Lansing to Clare 8 years ago. Richard enjoyed spending time with his family, friends and loved ones, his hobbies included landscaping his lawn, repairing automobiles and listening to Johnny Cash.

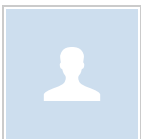
