



Robert L. Jenkins Sr.

January 17, 1922 - August 2, 2015

Robert Jenkins, 93, of Farwell, passed away on August 2, 2015 at Northwoods of Farwell with his family by his side. He was born in Coleman, Michigan to Paul and Lepha (Smith) Jenkins on Jan. 17, 1922. Robert met and married Fern Atkinson on June 22nd, 1944. To this union were born five daughters, Charlene (the late William) Dubuque, Candice (the late John) Barcume, Deborah (Clyde) Price, Judy (Wayne) Beal, Roberta Jenkins, two sons, Robert (Lisa) Jenkins Jr., Michael (Janice) Jenkins. Also surviving are 27 Grandchildren, 30 great-grandchildren, and three great-great-grandchildren, and his brother, Roger (Carol) Jenkins of Coleman. Robert was predeceased by his parents, three brothers, Ronald, Lyle, and Delmar, and two sisters, Mary and Lauris, his wife Fern, and his daughter, Tonda.

Robert had worked for Twin Pines and Mueller Brass in Port Huron and the Mount Pleasant Regional Center for Developmental Disabilities. He was a Minister in the Community of Christ Church and attended the Farwell Community of Christ. He had also served in the US Army from 1941 - 1944 during WWII and received a Purple Heart. He was also a Captain in the US Coast Guard Auxiliary in Port Huron. He enjoyed camping, traveling, fishing in Canada, and spending time with family.
