Roderick Aaron, age 77, of Farwell, passed away on Monday, Dec. 31, 2012, at the Tendercare Nursing Home in Clare. He was born the son of Nathaniel and Lucille (Dorman) Aaron on May 26, 1935, in Fultondale, Alabama. He had served 12 years with the US Air force as a Firefighter during the Korean War and until 1962. Upon leaving military service he became the primary caregiver for his parents.
