Romagne Hemstreet, age 94 of Clare, passed away peacefully on Sunday, January 15, 2017 at the Medilodge Nursing Center of Clare. Romagne was born the eldest daughter of Al and Bessie (Hargrave) Perry on September 22, 1922 in Clare, where she has resided her entire life. On April 20, 1946, she was united in marriage to Jack Hemstreet, her husband of 70 years. Romagne was a member of the Clare Congregational Church and also a lifetime member of the Order of the Eastern Star. She enjoyed keeping herself busy at home by cooking and cleaning, and in her earlier years she liked to visit the casino to play bingo, listen to the radio, and watch an occasional soap opera.
