Rondell L. "Ron" Bisbee, age 79, of Farwell, passed away on Tuesday, August 30, 2016 at the MidMichigan Medical Center in Midland. He was born the son of Forrest and Gladys (Gosling) Bisbee on September 27, 1936 in Detroit. He married Mary Harrison in 1959 and she survives him. Ron had served in the Michigan National Guard and had been a Sales Representative with Eco Lab. He and Mary moved their family to Farwell from Livonia in 1977 with a brief stopover in Cleveland, Ohio. He attended the Clare Church of the Nazarene.
