



## Ruth Myers

September 14, 1931 - December 23, 2020

Ruth Myers (Ogilvie), age 89 of Clare, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, December 23, 2020 at the MidMichigan Medical Center of Clare. On September 14, 1931, Ruth was born the daughter of James and Elizabeth (Squire) Ogilvie in Scottville, MI. Sadly, Ruth's mother Elizabeth passed away very early in Ruth's childhood, and it was after this that her father married Marie Porter, who cared for and raised Ruth throughout her life as if she was always her own. On April 14, 1951, Ruth was united in marriage to Forrest "Babe" Myers in Scottville, MI., and the pair shared just over sixty-nine years of marriage together before Babe's passing on August 12, 2020. Ruth and Babe moved to Clare in the late 1950's after Babe was hired at Clare's Giant Way Grocery as a meat cutter.
