



Thelma Hardin

February 28, 1920 - March 9, 2014

The Rev. Thelma Hardin, 94 of Farwell, went home to be with her Lord and Savior on Sunday, March 9, 2014. Born in Normal, IL on February 28, 1920, she was the daughter of Ray and Edith (Rexroat) Hargis. Thelma accepted Jesus as her Savior in 1935. Thelma was the beloved wife of the late Rev. Kenneth L. Hardin (May 7, 2010) whom she married on March 31, 1937. They went on to minister together for the next 60 years in Kentucky, Illinois, Indiana, California, Washington, Idaho, and Michigan. They began their ministry in Michigan in 1953 and held full time pastorates in White Cloud, Boyne City, Marshall, Clare, St. Helen and Mt. Pleasant. They retired in 1998, at which time they were serving as associate pastors in Harrison.

Thelma is survived by her daughter Cheri and Ron Cook of Farwell, her granddaughter Becky Gillis and her three girls Halee, Jordyn, and Makenna, and her grandson Jim and Jennifer Cook and their three kids Trent, Landon, and Katie. Thelma was preceded in death by her parents and husband.
