



## Thomas J. Breault

January 20, 1962 - August 29, 2021

Thomas J. Breault, age 59 of Clare, passed away peacefully on Sunday, August 29, 2021 at the Prestige Place Assisted Living Home of Clare. On January 20, 1962, Tom was born the son of Ralph Milton and Ruth (McClelland) Breault in Detroit, MI. Tom remained a lifetime resident of the Northwest Metro Detroit area for the majority of his life, having graduated from Churchill High School in Livonia in 1980. It wasn't until May of 2021 that Tom moved from Redford to Clare to be closer to family.
