



## Thomas John Gyulveszi

October 20, 1944 - August 13, 2013

Thomas John Gyulveszi, age 68 of Lake, passed away Tuesday, August 13, 2013 at the Masonic Pathways in Alma. Thomas was born the son of Michael and Lillian (Smith) Gyulveszi on October 20, 1944 in Detroit. He was united in marriage to Gale "Diane" Smith on June 22, 1968 in Trenton. Thomas had served in the Navy on the Aircraft Carrier U.S.S. Forrestal during the Vietnam War. Thomas and Diane had moved to Lake from Taylor in 1984 to own and operate the Lake Roller Rink. Prior to operating the Roller Rink, Thomas had worked as a Systems Electronic Technician at a Steel Manufacturing Plant downstate.
