Thomas R. Hamilton, age 76 of Warren, passed away Saturday, May 29, 2021 at Henry Ford Health System – Macomb. Tom was born on January 1, 1945 to the late Ralph C. and Grace V. (Garrity) Hamilton of Alger. He graduated from the Standish-Sterling High School in Standish in 1963 and attended Michigan Technology University for one year. He then worked in the automotive industry in Lansing. He married Annette Gale, daughter of Charlie and Carolyn Gale in Lansing on December 18, 1965. Tom enlisted in the Air Force in 1966 and was in a short while but had to take a hardship discharge.
