



Thomas E. Kedrowski

January 26, 1947 - January 5, 2026

Thomas Eldon Kedrowski, age 78 of Farwell, passed away Monday, January 5, 2026 at the University of Florida Health Leesburg Hospital in Leesburg, FL. Tom was born the son of the late Leonard and Catherine (Carlson) Kedrowski on January 26, 1947 in Cadillac. He was a graduate of Cadillac High School class of 1965; going on to earn his bachelor's degree from Ferris State College. He was united in marriage to Patricia Loomis in their hometown of Cadillac on September 7, 1968. Tom was a proud member of the U.S. Army during the Vietnam Era, and upon his return from service he worked with the FDIC before moving to Farwell and serving 33 years at the Farwell State Savings Bank—a career that led to many cherished friendships. Those close to Tom know he enjoyed spending time with family, golfing at and supporting Eagle Glen, and collecting thriller novels. He was a big car enthusiast, always excited to try something new.

Tom is survived by his wife Trish; children David (Ann) Kedrowski of Maine and Julie (David) Ranck of Coleman; his grandchildren Brianna (Trevor) Arnold of Clare and Bailey (significant other Tucker Roehrs) of Freeland; his step-grandchildren Christopher (Heather) Chamberlain of Illinois and Joshua Duranceau of Traverse City; step-great-grandchildren Brooklyn, Crew, Aubrie and Taliesin; as well as his brother James (Cynthia) Kedrowski of Florida. Tom was preceded in death by his parents Leonard and Catherine Kedrowski.

A funeral mass in honor of Tom will take place on Monday, January 12, 2026 at 11:00 A.M. at the Our Lady of Hope Parish-St. Cecilia Site with Monsignor Francis Koper officiating. Burial will follow in the St. Cecilia Catholic Cemetery. Visitation will be held on Sunday the 11th at the Farwell Chapel of the Stephenson-Wyman Funeral Home from 2:00 P.M. to 5:00 P.M and again from 7:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M. 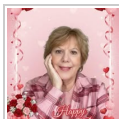
