Thomas E. Wood, Jr., age 65 of Lake George, MI. and New Richey, FL., passed away peacefully at the MidMichigan Medical Center of Midland on Sunday, July 2, 2017. Tom was born the son of Thomas and Alice (Abernathy) Wood, Sr. in Flint, MI. on March 5, 1952. On July 18, 1991, Tom was united in marriage to his best friend Jodi Brohn. Tom was a proud member of the General Motors Truck and Bus assembly line team, having worked a faithful thirty-three years under GM. Shortly after his retirement in 2005, Tom and Jodi moved to their home on Lake George where Tom loved tending his yard and gardens.

Tom is survived by his wife and best friend Jodi Wood, his two sons Corey and Timothy (Mariah) Wood, three sisters Susan (Michael) Sobol, Sheryl (Gary) Ackerman, and Sharmon (Greg) Kehler, and “special brother” James (Erin) Brohn.
