



Timothy R. Krabill

June 25, 1959 - November 10, 2022

Timothy Robert Krabill – Age 63 of Lake, passed away on Thursday, November 10, 2022 after a long battle with cancer. He was born to parents, Robert and Colleen (Phenix) Krabill in Clare, Michigan on June 25, 1959. He enlisted in the US Navy in 1978 and was stationed at Miramar Naval Air Station serving as a fighter jet mechanic. Tim spoke fondly of having to crawl into the engines to repair all types of aircraft, but enjoyed his work on fighter jets the most. He then worked several years in the oil fields working with his cousin, Quentin, and held several jobs subsequent to that until his illness. Tim enjoyed hunting, fishing, and was always up for a good party with friends.

Tim is survived by his brothers David (Becky) Krabill of Mt. Pleasant, Steven (Irene) Krabill of Saginaw, Daniel (Debbie) Krabill of Lake, seven nieces and nephews and eighteen great nieces and nephews, many cousins, aunts and uncles. He was predeceased by his father on October 28, 2022, his mother on May 2, 2017, an infant sister, Katherine Ann in 1957, as well as both sets of grandparents.

Per Tim's request cremation has already taken place. A Public Memorial Service will be held on Saturday, November 19, 2022, from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm at the Lake Eagles Aerie 3761, 8460 Ludington Drive, Lake, Michigan followed by a Private Family Memorial Service.
