



Virginia Rae "Jean" Irwin

August 6, 1923 - February 2, 2014

Virginia Rae "Jean" Irwin, age 90, of Farwell, passed away on Sunday, February 2, at MidMichigan Medical Center in Clare. She was born the daughter of Earl and Florence (Cover) Green on August 6, 1923, in Pontiac. Her family moved to the Farwell area around 1930. She married Lewis Irwin on Feb. 28, 1942 and he preceded her in death on Mar. 2, 2005. She had worked at Holley Carburetor during her working life. Virginia had graduated from Harrison High School in the Class of 1941. She had been one of the founding members of Bethany Baptist Church, in Lake, and was very proud of her membership in the Daughters of the American Revolution.

Survivors include her children, Betty Hanchett of Clare, Kathleen (Norm) Brown of Farwell, Lewis "Arlo" Irwin Jr. of Clare, 12 grandchildren, 28 great-grandchildren, and seven great-great-grandchildren.
