



## Vivian F. Demo

July 26, 1920 - October 29, 2014

Vivian F. Demo, age 94, of Clare, passed away on Wednesday, October 29, surrounded by her family at Tendercare of Clare. She was born the daughter of George and Florence (Nicholas) Schnaidt on July 26, 1920 in Oakland County. She married Chris G. Demo on August 3, 1944 and he preceded her in death on August 11, 1995. She and Chris had been business partners and had moved to Clare from Pontiac to Open Clare's Twin Elms, later they owned and operated the former Amoco, (now Marathon) station at Clare's north interchange and they had also owned the Dairy Phil for a time. Vivian had served in the Women's Army Corps, which she very much enjoyed. She was also instrumental in starting the Clare Public School's school lunch program. Vivian is survived by her children, Diane Demo-Sadler of Clare and Chris G. Demo Jr., also of Clare, her grandchildren, Christina Virojanavat, David Sadler, Sydney Demo, and Brock Demo. She was preceded in death by her husband, her parents, and her siblings, George, Violet, Edna, Thelma, Mac, and Marion.

Vivian was an independent woman and had impressed upon her family that there were to be no formal memorial services following her death. Her family is choosing to honor her wishes.
