Wayne W. Cavalieri, age 73, of Farwell, passed away on Saturday, December 6, 2014, at MidMichigan Medical Center in Midland. 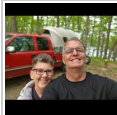

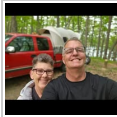

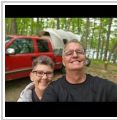
